Tuesday, February 5, 2013

The Gulf County School Board met in regular session Tuesday, February 5, 2013, at 10:00 A. M. at their Administrative Office in Port St. Joe. The following board members were present: Chairman Linda R. Wood, Danny Little, Billy C. Quinn, Jr., and John Wright. Superintendent Norton and Attorney Costin were also present. Mr. Cox was unable to attend the meeting.

BOARD MEETING AGENDA:

I. HEAR FROM THE PUBLIC:

The Board was pleased to recognize students from this year's Three Rivers Regional Science Fair competition. Both Wewahitchka High School students will proceed to state competition.

Cordale Green won 2nd overall in the Physical Sciences category and three special awards: The United States Army Award, The Office of Naval Research Naval Science Award, Association for Unmanned Vehicle Systems International Emerald Coast Chapter Award for demonstrating exceptional understanding of unmanned systems of scientific or engineering principles. Cordale was accompanied to the meeting by his teacher, Ms. Kimberly McMillion, who helped explain the science fair process. **Shelby Wood** was unable to make the meeting, however she won 3rd overall in the Biological Sciences category and one special award: Olive Leaves for Excellence in Science. Also recognized was **Hannah Anderson**, who received recognition for her project "The Effect of Caffeine on Plants". Hannah was 1 of 5 students to receive an award from the United States Army for Outstanding Science Fair Project.
