

# GULF COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD

Tuesday, September 16, 2014

The Gulf County School Board met in special session Tuesday, September 16, 2014, at 12:00 P. M., E. S. T., at their Administrative Office in Port St. Joe. The following board members were present: Chairman Linda R. Wood, Vice-Chairman George M. Cox, Danny Little, Billy C. Quinn, Jr., and John Wright. Superintendent Norton and Attorney Costin were also present.

I. **CALL TO ORDER:** Chairman Wood called the meeting to order at 12:00.
