SPECIAL MEETING

Thursday, April 16, 2015

The Gulf County School Board met in special session Thursday, April 16, 2015, at Noon E. T., at their Administrative Office in Port St. Joe. Attorney Costin and the following board members were present: Chairman Danny Little, Vice-Chairman John Wright, Billy C. Quinn, Jr., Linda R. Wood, and Brooke Wooten. Assistant Superintendent Bill Carr chaired the meeting for Superintendent Norton who was attending a meeting at Sacred Heart.

I. **CALL TO ORDER:** Chairman Little called the meeting to order at 12:00.
